- Scholarships are awarded to graduating seniors who have demonstrated outstanding passion, involvement, and skill in vocal performance throughout their high school years.
- Students involved in choir and musical theater are encouraged to apply. Although we hope you will continue to be involved in the performing arts in the future, declaring a related Performance Major in college is **not** required.
- **1 year of participation** in any VPA choir required.
- Submit the signed and dated application form.
- Please attach an **original essay** (500 words or less, type-written, single-spaced) describing how your involvement in **vocal performance** has enriched your life and how you expect your experiences to influence your future.
- Obtain **2 recommendations** from instructors or mentors and include them (in sealed envelopes).
- Students may apply for any combination of VPA scholarships (Vocal Performance, Kris Kearsley Visual Arts, or Amanda Polopolous Theatre Arts and Design). The essay and recommendations can be submitted for multiple applications, however, please submit a copy for each scholarship. Applicants will only be eligible to receive a single award.
- All materials must be mailed to the Voices for the Performing Arts Foundation, Attn: Scholarship, PO Box 594, Sherwood OR 97140. **Postmarked by Friday, April 12, 2019.**
- Scholarship recipients will be selected and applicants notified by May 13, 2019.

**Note:** Award certificates will be presented to scholarship winners at the SHS Honors Banquet June 3<sup>rd</sup> and at the VPA Spring Concert on May 16<sup>th</sup>. Please mark the dates on your schedule. Scholarship recipients' attendance is requested.
